



## Leader Commitment/Covenant

### Requirements:

- Show signs of being a growing follower of Christ
- Display evidence of gifts and abilities for teaching and shepherding people
- Complete basic LifeGroup leadership training class
- Be a participating member of Mountain View Church

### Responsibilities:

#### 1) Seek to develop your LifeGroup leadership team by

- Vision Casting
- Consistently working on developing your skills as a leader
- Recruiting, training, and encouraging your host and apprentice
- Involving others in appropriate leadership roles in your group

#### 2) Seek to lead your LifeGroup meeting by

- Selecting curriculum that is appropriate and applicable to your group
- Developing an agenda each week that creates an atmosphere for ministry to take place
- Preparing to lead and facilitate your meetings each week
- Encouraging and delegating with your coach and apprentice

#### 3) Seek to Shepherd your LifeGroup by

- Praying consistently for individual members of your group
- Encouraging your group through phone calls, personal notes, meeting any needs, etc. Encourage other group members to do the same
- Planning occasional social functions for the group (suggested once per quarter)

#### 4) Seek to involve your LifeGroup in service by

- Casting a vision for the importance of service
- Helping plan and execute one service project per year

#### 5) See to multiply your LifeGroup by

- Casting the vision for the importance of multiplication
- With the assistance of the pastoral leadership and coach preparing your apprentice and group for multiplication

**6) Seek to be a part of the LifeGroup Ministry Team by**

- Attending monthly LifeGroup Leader Huddle meeting. Huddles are during the the first Sunday of the Month
- Maintaining regular contact with your LifeGroup Pastor/coach as he/she encourages you through personal meetings, phone calls, or e-mail
- Filing a monthly report online with the office**
