KidzRock Memory Verses: Here are the current memory verses the kids are learning. Remember, it only takes a moment to go over your kid's verses with them each day, but the results will last a lifetime.

Elementary: *Lord, your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior Who saves. He will take great delight in you; in His love He will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing.* (Zephaniah 3:27)

Wildlife Woods (4's and 5's) and Cascade Camp (Kindergarten): *Show me Your ways, Lord, teach me Your paths. Guide me in Your truth and teach me, for You are God my Savior, and my hope is in You all day long.* (Psalm 25:4-5)

Tiny Timbers and Treeline Climb (2's and 3's): *Today in the town of David, a Savior has been born to you; He is the Messiah, the Lord.* (Luke 2:11)
